The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) **SUPPORTS** SB878 SD1, which authorizes the use of composting toilets to meet the wastewater needs of rural and other areas.

OHA believes that this measure has the potential to reduce human waste impacts on coastlines, undeveloped areas of cultural significance, and rural regions where many of our beneficiaries reside. Particularly in rural areas and properties where septic and municipal sewer infrastructure may be costly or impractical to install, composting toilets may, in some cases, be an environmentally-friendly and cost-effective means to meet local wastewater needs.

OHA appreciates the amendments made to this measure, in allowing counties to determine the most appropriate circumstances under which composting toilets may be installed. In some cases, what could be defined as “composting toilets” may be inappropriate or ineffective for properly treating or dealing with human waste. For example, composting toilets in areas with a high amount of human activity may not be able to sufficiently process the volume of waste that they may receive, after installation. In addition, this measure’s broad definition of “composting toilet,” as any facility that uses “no water or very little water” and “natural processes,” appears broad enough to encompass any toilet design that does not use synthetic chemicals to treat raw sewage, regardless of any environmental or hygienic considerations. Allowing counties to draw upon their localized and subject matter expertise in evaluating and approving composting toilet proposals will better ensure that composting toilets are appropriately designed and installed.

Accordingly, OHA urges the Committee to **PASS** SB878 SD1.
