Bill No. and Title: Senate Bill No. 3085, SD1, Relating to the Hawaii Code of Military Justice.

Purpose: Updates the Hawaii Code of Military Justice, by repealing chapter 124A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and adding a new chapter to promote order and discipline in the State Military Forces by fostering an independent military justice system and updating nonjudicial punishment and courts-martial procedures. Effective 1/1/2023.
