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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to comply with the  
2 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to require, in part,  
3 that state and local government entities ensure that all  
4 programs, services, or activities be accessible to persons with  
5 disabilities.

6           SECTION 2. Section 92-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

8           "(a) The board shall give written public notice of any  
9 regular, special, or rescheduled meeting, or any executive  
10 meeting when anticipated in advance. The notice shall include  
11 an agenda which lists [all]:

12           (1) All of the items to be considered at the forthcoming  
13 meeting~~[, the]~~;

14           (2) The date, time, and place of the meeting, and in the  
15 case of an executive meeting the purpose shall be  
16 stated~~[,]~~; and



1        (3) A telephone number, facsimile number, and email  
2                    address for individuals with disabilities to contact  
3                    if they need an accommodation.

4        The means specified by this section shall be the only means  
5 required for giving notice under this part notwithstanding any  
6 law to the contrary."

7        SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9        SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
