# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 27G-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "~~§~~27G-3~~§~~ **Access Hawaii committee; establishment;**  
4 **membership; chairperson.** (a) There is established within the  
5 department of accounting and general services, the access Hawaii  
6 committee.

7           (b) The committee shall consist of not more than fifteen  
8 voting ex officio members, or their designated representatives,  
9 as follows:

- 10           (1) The comptroller;
- 11           (2) The administrator of the information and communication  
12 services division of the department of accounting and  
13 general services;
- 14           (3) The administrator of the state procurement office;
- 15           (4) The director of the office of information practices;
- 16           (5) The directors of not more than three government  
17 agencies using or planning to use the services of the  
18 portal manager;



- 1 (6) The administrative director of the courts;
- 2 (7) A representative of the Hawaii state senate appointed  
3 by the president of the senate;
- 4 (8) A representative of the Hawaii state house of  
5 representatives appointed by the speaker of the house  
6 of representatives; ~~and~~
- 7 (9) The chief information officers of the four  
8 counties~~[-]~~; and
- 9 (10) The chief information officer.

10 (c) The ~~comptroller~~ chief information officer or the  
11 chief information officer's designee shall serve as the  
12 chairperson of the committee."

13 SECTION 2. Section 27G-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 "[~~§~~27G-5~~§~~] **Annual report.** The committee shall submit  
16 an annual report to the governor and the legislature no later  
17 than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session,  
18 on the operations of the portal. The annual report shall  
19 include the portal manager's annual financial reports."

20 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

22 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



**Report Title:**

Access Hawaii Committee; Chief Information Officer; Reporting

**Description:**

Designates the chief information officer or the chief information officer's designee to serve on and chair the access Hawaii committee. Requires the access Hawaii committee to include the portal manager's financial reports in its annual report to the legislature. (SD1).
