
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that with the relocation
2 of the Honolulu fire department engine twenty-four, which
3 services Ewa Beach, its response times to certain areas may be
4 lengthened. The legislature also finds that the prior location
5 of engine twenty-four is an ideal one for an ambulance service.
6 By triangulating first responders and emergency medical
7 services, the Ewa Beach area would realize improved access to
8 emergency medical care and ambulance services.

9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds to
10 the department of health to demolish the Ewa Beach fire facility
11 and construct an energy-efficient and environmentally-
12 sustainable emergency medical services facility at the same
13 location.

14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,750,000 or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the
17 demolition of the Ewa Beach fire station (TMK 9-1-025-062) and
18 the construction of an energy-efficient and environmentally-



1 sustainable emergency medical services facility at the same
2 location.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
