
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part XI to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§291C- Ordinances authorizing county use of wheel
5 boots for parking violations. (a) Notwithstanding any other
6 law to the contrary, each county may ordain any ordinance
7 authorizing:

8 (1) The county police department or any other designated
9 county agent to apply a wheel boot to any motor
10 vehicle for any parking violation; and

11 (2) The collection of a county fee to apply or remove the
12 wheel boot.

13 (b) Unless authorized by a county pursuant to subsection
14 (a) (1), no person shall apply a wheel boot to a motor vehicle
15 unless the person applying the wheel boot is the registered
16 owner of the motor vehicle.

17 (c) For purposes of this section, "wheel boot" includes a
18 tire lock, denver boot, wheel clamp, or wheel immobilizer."

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Authorizes ordinances permitting county use of wheel boots for parking violations. Establishes that unless authorized by a county, no person, other than the registered owner of a motor vehicle, may apply a wheel boot to a motor vehicle. (SB1214 HD1)
