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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public disclosure of  
2 incomes of state employees and legislators enhances public trust  
3 because the disclosure tends to reduce real and perceived  
4 conflicts of interest.

5           The purpose of this Act is to require a state employee or  
6 legislator to disclose every source of annual income that totals  
7 more than the employee's or legislator's annual salary if that  
8 source is a registered lobbyist or lobbying organization.

9           SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
10 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
11 read as follows:

12           "§84-       Additional requirements of disclosure.  
13 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, and in addition  
14 to the requirements of section 84-17, an employee or legislator  
15 shall disclose every source of annual income that totals more  
16 than the employee's or legislator's annual salary if that source  
17 is a registered lobbyist or lobbying organization."



1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2113.
