

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-359, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) as follows:

3 "(b) A contribution by the candidate's immediate family
4 shall be exempt from section [~~11-355,~~] 11-357, but shall be
5 limited in the aggregate to \$50,000 in any election period;
6 provided that the aggregate amount of loans and contributions
7 received from the candidate's immediate family does not exceed
8 \$50,000 during an election period."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
