
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 58, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended
2 by section 50 of Act 22, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, as amended
3 by section 1 of Act 306, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, as amended
4 by section 12 of Act 5, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as
5 amended by section 5 of Act 102, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
6 amended by amending section 14 to read as follows:

7 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
8 provided that:

9 (1) The amendments made to sections 40-1, 40-4, and 40-6,
10 Hawaii Revised Statutes, by part I of this Act shall
11 not be repealed when those sections are reenacted on
12 June 30, 2006, by section 1 of Act 137, Session Laws

11 SECTION 2. Section 201B-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 "(c) Moneys in the tourism special fund shall be used by
14 the authority for the purposes of this chapter; provided that:

15 (1) Not more than ~~[five]~~ 6.5 per cent of this amount shall
16 be used for administrative expenses, including \$15,000
17 for a protocol fund to be expended at the discretion
18 of the president and chief executive officer; and

19 (2) At least \$1,000,000 shall be made available to support
20 efforts to manage, improve, and protect Hawaii's
21 natural environment and areas frequented by visitors."

Makes permanent exemptions granted to the HTA from requirements for Comptroller's supervision of accounts, publication of consolidated financial statements, approval of business and accounting forms, and deposit of funds into the tourism special fund. Increases Tourism Special Fund allowance for HTA administrative expenses. (HB1259 HD1)

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
