A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that residents of the
2 island of Hawaii would greatly benefit from the addition of an
3 advanced life support ambulance to augment the Hawaii county
4 emergency medical services system for residents of the Makalei
5 area. The population of this area has significantly increased
6 over the years, which has corresponded with a steady increase in
7 calls for emergency medical services.

8 The legislature further finds that access to primary health
9 care in Malakei is challenging for the community. For many
10 residents, primary care services are as many as thirty miles
11 away. Coupled with economic and transportation challenges,
12 emergency medical services have become the access point for
13 health care to many residents.

14 Due to the lack of resources, it has become common for
15 medics to have up to ten transports in a twenty-four hour shift.
16 The potential for fatigue resulting in errors in judgment,



1 driving, and overall safety are of great concern for personnel
2 and residents.

3 The legislature further finds that a new advanced life
4 support ambulance will help reduce death and disability among
5 residents and visitors on the island of Hawaii. A timely
6 response to a 911 call is critical to increase the likelihood of
7 successful outcomes for injured or sick individuals. Given the
8 island's significant growth and aging population, an advanced
9 life support ambulance is needed and will be cost-effective.

10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for an
11 advanced life support ambulance to be based in the Makalei area
12 on the island of Hawaii and to be used during daily peak hours
13 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., including the acquisition of a
14 vehicle and equipment, and funding personnel costs for state-
15 certified emergency medical service personnel.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary for the fiscal year 2015-2016 and
19 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
20 fiscal year 2016-2017 for one advanced life support ambulance to
21 be:

- 1 (1) Based in Makalei on the island of Hawaii; and
- 2 (2) Used during daily peak hours from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00
- 3 p.m.;


4 and to include the acquisition of a vehicle and equipment, and
 5 funding personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical
 6 service personnel.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 8 of health for the purposes of this Act.


9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
