Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 543

The purpose of this measure is to improve operations at the  
University of Hawaii by requiring the Auditor to conduct audits of  
the University of Hawaii's management of faculty workload no less  
than one year prior to the expiration of each faculty union  
collective bargaining agreement and report findings and  
recommendations to the Legislature.

The University of Hawaii Professional Assembly and a  
concerned individual opposed the measure. The University of  
Hawaii submitted comments.
