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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,988,215 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016  
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
6 the first representative district, as follows:

 10 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
 11 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

12 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 13 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 14 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of  
 15 this Act.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
