
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$490,320 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 as a grant
4 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Bay Clinic,
5 Inc., for a mobile health unit to provide health services in the
6 Puna district on the island of Hawaii due to the threat of
7 inaccessibility from the lava flow.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
