
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal and
3 abolish various non-general funds pursuant to the
4 recommendations made by the auditor in auditor's report nos. 14-
5 04 and 14-13.

6 PART II

7 SECTION 2. The purpose of this part is to repeal the
8 cancer detection development revolving fund.

9 The legislature finds that the fund does not serve the
10 purpose for which it was created and does not meet the criteria
11 for a revolving fund.

12 SECTION 3. Section 211F-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 repealed

14 ~~["§211F-5.5] Cancer detection development revolving fund,~~
15 ~~establishment. (a) There is established the cancer detection~~
16 ~~development revolving fund to be administered by the Hawaii~~
17 ~~strategic development corporation to assist enterprises that~~

3 ~~(b) The fund shall not be considered part of the general~~

8 ~~(4) Received pursuant to a venture agreement;~~

13 PART III

14 SECTION 4. The following funds and accounts are abolished:

15 (1) The Hawaii criminal justice commission trust account
16 established in 1985 and administered by the department
17 of the attorney general;

18 (2) The preservation of endangered plants administratively
19 established in 1989 and administered by the department
20 of land and natural resources;



1 (3) The State DOD physical amelioration donation
2 administratively established in 2010 and administered
3 by the department of defense; and
4 (4) The UH wellness center - operating account
5 administratively established in 2008 and administered
6 by the University of Hawaii,
7 and any remaining unencumbered balances shall be transferred to
8 the general fund.

9 PART IV

10 SECTION 5. On July 1, 2015, all unencumbered balances
11 remaining in the cancer detection development revolving fund
12 repealed by section 3 of this Act shall lapse to the credit of
13 the general fund.

14 PART V

15 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken.

17 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
