
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the small business
2 regulatory review board provides comments and input on the
3 administrative rulemaking process and provides recommendations
4 to the legislature, governor, and the counties on rule changes
5 to help small businesses. The legislature also finds that the
6 board lacks sufficient staff to fulfill its mission effectively.

7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
8 department of business, economic development, and tourism to
9 enable the small business regulatory review board to
10 hire additional staff.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
15 2016-2017 for the small business regulatory review board to
16 hire additional staff.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
3 of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2053.
