
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AHA MOKU ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO ENGAGE
STAKEHOLDERS IN ORDER TO DEVELOP AND ADOPT RULES FOR ITS
OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION.

1 WHEREAS, the Aha Moku Advisory Committee was authorized
2 pursuant to Act 288, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012 (Act 288); and
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4 WHEREAS, the legislative intent in authorizing the Aha Moku
5 Advisory Committee included providing an opportunity for
6 Hawaiians to work together to exhibit that traditional Hawaiian
7 values and customs could be applicable to modern governmental
8 affairs; and
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10 WHEREAS, it was the intent of the Legislature in passing
11 Act 288 that the Aha Moku Advisory Committee have some
12 independence from state government to reflect its role of
13 working alongside and advising state government with regard to
14 Hawaiian traditions, values, and practices; now, therefore,
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16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
17 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
18 Session of 2015, that the Aha Moku Advisory Committee, with
19 assistance from the Department of Land and Natural Resources,
20 Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and Association of Hawaiian Civic
21 Clubs, is requested to engage stakeholders for the purpose of
22 developing and adopting rules for its operation and
23 administration; and
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25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Aha Moku Advisory Committee
26 report back to the Legislature regarding the development and
27 adoption of rules no later than twenty days prior to the
28 convening of the Regular Session of 2016; and



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
2 Resolution be transmitted to the Chair of the Aha Moku Advisory
3 Committee, Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural
4 Resources, Chief Executive Officer of the Office of Hawaiian
5 Affairs, and President of the Association of Hawaiian Civic
6 Clubs.
