SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A SUNRISE ANALYSIS OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.

1 WHEREAS, the present licensing statutes for psychologists,
2 pursuant to section 465-3(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes, does not
3 apply to school psychologists in the public sector, rendering
4 them an unregulated profession, while school psychologists in
5 the private sector are subject to licensure; and

7 WHEREAS, school psychologists are therefore a partially
8 regulated profession such that the unregulated portion could
9 potentially bring harm to students; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the partial regulation of the school psychologist
12 profession also appears unfair and inconsistent from the point
13 of view of school psychologists; and

15 WHEREAS, school psychologists appear to be a regulated
16 profession in other states such as Florida and Maine; now,
17 therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
20 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the
21 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is
22 requested to conduct a sunrise analysis of S.B. No. ,
23 introduced during the Regular Session of 2016; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
26 submit findings and recommendations, including any proposed
27 legislation, to the Legislature not less than twenty days prior
28 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2017; and
