A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to the state foundation on culture and the arts artist
3 fellowship program for the awarding of one-time fellowships to
4 promising artists in the amount of not less than \$25,000.

5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
9 2018-2019 for the state foundation on culture and the arts
10 artist fellowship program for the awarding of one-time
11 fellowships to promising artists in the amount of not less than
12 \$25,000.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the state
14 foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.


