
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The state auditor shall conduct an audit
2 of each domestic violence nonprofit organization that has
3 received state funds in the past five years. The audits shall
4 focus on accountability and oversight of the state funding
5 including:

6 (1) The percentage of each nonprofit organization's total
7 budget that is used for staff and administrative costs
8 compared to the costs of providing services directly
9 for domestic violence victims;

10 (2) Recommendations to improve comprehensive care for
11 domestic violence victims; and

12 (3) Recommendations on how domestic violence nonprofit
13 organizations can increase efficiency by reducing
14 staff and administrative costs so that more funds may
15 be expended for the direct benefit of domestic
16 violence victims.





1 (b) The state auditor shall submit a report of its
2 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
3 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
4 to the convening of the regular session of 2019.

5 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
