
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3 as follows:

4 "CHAPTER

5 DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS RECORDS

6 § -1 Government records and personal records;
7 department of Hawaiian home lands. (a) The following
8 government records maintained by the department of Hawaiian home
9 lands shall not be required to be publicly disclosed or made
10 open to inspection pursuant to public records requests under
11 section 92F-11:

- 12 (1) Loan applications, loan prequalification documents,
13 loan approval documents, underwriting findings,
14 financial data forms, and financial assessments except
15 where disclosure is required by section 92F-12(a)(8);
- 16 (2) Any consent to release personal information permitting
17 the department of Hawaiian home lands to access birth,



1 marriage, and death certificates and other documents
2 in the application or lessee file to assist the family
3 or individual designated by the applicant or lessee
4 with the processing of an application or lease award;
5 (3) Designation of successor to a lease;
6 (4) Designation of successor to application rights for a
7 homestead lease;
8 (5) Requests to succeed to a homestead lease; and
9 (6) Requests to succeed to application rights.
10 (b) The Hawaiian homes commission may hold an executive
11 meeting as provided in section 92-4 for the purpose of
12 discussing the records made exempt from public disclosure by
13 subsection (a) in the same manner as for the purposes listed in
14 section 92-5(a)."
15 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
