Clarifies that an individual who accompanies an athlete or team of athletes into this State for a temporary period is not required to possess a valid license, registration, or certification from another jurisdiction if that jurisdiction does not regulate athletic trainers. Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LICENSING. Clarifies that the licensing requirements for hearing aid dealers and fitters shall not apply to audiologists licensed pursuant to chapter 468E, Hawaii Revised Statutes.	CPH
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO DENTAL LICENSURE. Requires the board of dental examiners to issue a license by credentials to a practicing dentist who is licensed in another state and meets other specific requirements.	CPH
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELORS. Amends the practicum experience requirements for qualification for licensure as a mental health counselor.	СРН
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE SUPERVISION OF LICENSED DENTAL HYGIENISTS IN A PUBLIC HEALTH SETTING. Allows licensed dental hygienists to practice under the general or direct supervision of any licensed dentist providing dental services in a public health setting.	CPH
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HEALTH CLUBS. Requires health clubs to maintain a surety bond of at least \$100,000 to be paid to any member who suffers loss of money paid due to the insolvency or cessation of operation of a health club.	СРН
