RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. HB 2693, HD2 PSM, JDC Prohibits places of public accommodation from denying shelter (HSCR831-18) to any person when an emergency alert advises the public to immediately seek shelter. Clarifies that the civil liability exemption applies to facilities receiving compensation and to property owners who sell commodities in the absence of price gouging.
