Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 115 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO
PRIORITIZE THE PLANTING OF FOUR MILLION TREES ALONG STREETS
AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE NEXT FOUR YEARS TO HELP ADDRESS
CLIMATE CHANGE AND MAKE COMPLETE STREETS STATEWIDE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request the
Governor to prioritize the planting of four million trees along
streets and roadways within the next four years to help address
climate change and make complete streets statewide.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Land and Natural Resources and one
individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to
this measure from one individual.


Your Committee finds that a single tree intakes carbon
dioxide and releases oxygen into the air; can absorb as much as
forty-eight pounds of carbon dioxide per year and sequester one
ton of carbon dioxide by the age of forty years; and also absorbs
odors and pollutant gases and filters particulates out of the air
by trapping the particulates on its leaves and bark. Your
Committee further finds that increased planting of trees along
roadways can increase shade and enhance safety for pedestrians.
Your Committee finds that the State can benefit from the planting



of additional trees along streets in an effort to sequester carbon, remove pollution, beautify and make complete streets, and reduce the severity of vehicle crashes.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 115 and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
