# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COURT PROCEEDINGS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 601, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§601- Constitutional and statutory claims; legislature;  
5 right of intervention. The legislature shall have standing to  
6 intervene in any court proceeding involving a claim that is  
7 based upon a constitutional or statutory provision."

8           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


