A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$700,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to provide
4 support for the expansion of the Kau rural health clinic to
5 improve access to urgent care and outpatient behavior health
6 services, thereby reducing the need for emergency services.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii health
8 systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
