
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE OF HAWAII MUSEUM OF MONARCHY HISTORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Iolani Palace is a
2 living legacy of a proud Hawaiian national identity and
3 represents the dignity and unique history of the people of
4 Hawaii. The legislature supports the palace's mission to
5 preserve, restore, interpret, share, and celebrate the unique
6 cultural, historical, and spiritual qualities of Iolani Palace
7 and its grounds for the benefit of native Hawaiians, the people
8 of Hawaii, and the greater world. The legislature notes that
9 recurring state funding should be designated to support the
10 mission of Iolani Palace as the State of Hawaii museum of
11 monarchy history.

12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
13 funds to the State of Hawaii museum of monarchy history for
14 restoration, repair, and one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
15 groundskeeper for Iolani Palace.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,325,000 or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to support
2 the operations, maintenance, restoration, and repair of Iolani
3 Palace; provided that:

4 (1) \$2,000,000 shall be designated for restoration and
5 repairs;

6 (2) \$250,000 shall be designated for operation and
7 maintenance; and

8 (3) \$ shall be designated for one full-time
9 equivalent (1.0 FTE) groundskeeper;

10 provided further that any funds appropriated pursuant to this
11 section shall be in addition to and shall not supplant any
12 portion of the base budget of the department of budget and
13 finance for the State of Hawaii museum of monarchy history.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
19 restoration, repair, and maintenance of Iolani Palace and nearby
20 structures located on palace grounds as follows:
