## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$9,204,250 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the second  
6 representative district, as follows:

7    1. Hilo high school track and field,  
8       Hawaii  
9       Construction and equipment for  
10      synthetic turf, rubberized track,  
11      bleachers, and equipment.

12      Construction	\$3,000,000
13      Equipment	\$500,000
14            Total funding	\$3,500,000

15           The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
16 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 2. Hilo intermediate school, Hawaii  
2 Construction and equipment for building  
3 A reroof and regutter; ground and site  
4 improvements; equipment and  
5 appurtenances.  
6 Construction \$1,375,000  
7 Equipment \$137,500  
8 Total funding \$1,512,500  
9 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
10 shall be expended by the department of education.

11 3. Keaukaha elementary school, Hawaii  
12 Construction and equipment for building  
13 B electrical upgrade; ground and site  
14 improvements; equipment and  
15 appurtenances.  
16 Construction \$230,000  
17 Equipment \$23,000  
18 Total funding \$253,000  
19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
20 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 4. Keaukaha elementary school, Hawaii  
2 Plans and design for a new STEAM  
3 building.

4 Plans \$1,000,000  
5 Design \$1,000,000

6 Total funding \$2,000,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
8 shall be expended by the department of education.

9 5. Waiakea high school, Hawaii

10 Plans, design, construction, and  
11 equipment for replacing the phone and  
12 PA system schoolwide.

13 Plans \$1,000  
14 Design \$1,000  
15 Construction \$1,000  
16 Equipment \$272,000

17 Total funding \$275,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
19 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 6. Waiakea intermediate school, Hawaii  
2 Construction and equipment for building  
3 G reroof; ground and site improvements;  
4 equipment and appurtenances.  
5 Construction \$212,500  
6 Equipment \$21,250  
7 Total funding \$233,750  
8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 7. Waiakeawaena elementary school, Hawaii  
11 Construction and equipment for building  
12 D reroof; ground and site improvements;  
13 equipment and appurtenances.  
14 Construction \$300,000  
15 Equipment \$30,000  
16 Total funding \$330,000  
17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
18 shall be expended by the department of education.

19 8. Waiakeawaena elementary school, Hawaii  
20 Plans and design for six new  
21 classrooms.


4       The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project

6       SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
10 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

11       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
