## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 342L-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3           "(b) Underground storage tank and tank system standards  
4 shall include, but are not limited to the following  
5 specifications:

6           (1) The tank and tank system shall be designed,  
7                 constructed, installed, upgraded, maintained,  
8                 repaired, and operated to prevent releases of the  
9                 stored regulated substances for the operational life  
10                of the tank or tank system;

11           (2) The material used in the construction or lining of the  
12                 tank or tank system is compatible with the substance  
13                 to be stored; [~~and~~]

14           (3) Existing underground storage tanks or existing tank  
15                 systems shall be replaced or upgraded not later than  
16                 December 22, 1998, to prevent releases for their  
17                 operating life[~~-~~]; and
