
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 421I, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§421I- Residential properties; zero-emission vehicle
5 fueling station plans; requirement. Each corporation shall have
6 plans to incorporate zero-emissions fueling stations, including
7 electric vehicle charging stations, onto any of its residential
8 properties that are constructed after January 1, 2023."

9 SECTION 2. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
11 and to read as follows:

12 "§421J- Residential properties; zero-emission vehicle
13 fueling station plans; requirement. Each association shall have
14 plans to incorporate zero-emissions fueling stations, including
15 electric vehicle charging stations, onto any of its residential
16 properties that are constructed after January 1, 2023."



1 SECTION 3. Chapter 514B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§514B- Residential properties; zero-emission vehicle
5 fueling station plans; requirement. Each association shall have
6 plans to incorporate zero-emissions fueling stations, including
7 electric vehicle charging stations, onto any of its residential
8 properties that are constructed after January 1, 2023."

9 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
