
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to
3 read as follows:
4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object,
5 district, area, or site, including heiau and underwater site,
6 [~~which~~] that is over [~~fifty~~] one hundred years old[-], or any
7 building, structure, district, area, or site that is over fifty
8 years old and that meets the criteria for being entered into the
9 Hawaii register of historic places."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 30, 2075.
