

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that noise pollution is a
- 2 serious problem affecting quality of life, particularly in urban
- 3 areas. Loud internal combustion engine mopeds are significant
- 4 contributors that have raised ongoing concerns in communities
- 5 throughout the State. Mopeds with factory mufflers are often
- 6 many times louder than larger motorcycles that have greater
- 7 engine displacement and robust exhaust baffles.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit a retailer from
- 9 selling or offering for sale any combustion engine-powered moped
- 10 unless the moped was initially purchased in a consumer
- 11 transaction prior to January 1, 2024.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 14 designated and to read as follows:
- 15 "§286- Sale of new combustion engine-powered mopeds;
- 16 prohibited; civil penalty; enforcement. (a) Beginning
- 17 January 1, 2024, no retailer shall sell or offer for sale any

- (b) This section shall not be construed to prohibit any 3
- individual or retailer from reselling, renting, or offering for 4
- resale or rent a combustion engine-powered moped that was 5
- 6 initially purchased in a consumer transaction prior to
- 7 January 1, 2024.
- 8 (c) Any person who violates this section shall be fined
- not more than \$1,000 for each separate offense. Each violation 9
- 10 shall constitute a separate offense.
- (d) For purposes of this section "retailer" means a person 11
- or entity that engages in the practice of selling mopeds to 12
- 13 consumers."
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 15
