A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that reliable irrigation
- 2 systems are the lifelines of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To
- 3 ensure that Hawaii's agricultural crops receive a steady and
- 4 dependable supply of water, sufficient funding is needed to
- 5 maintain and improve Hawaii's irrigation systems. Increasing
- 6 and extended water droughts have highlighted the need for the
- 7 repair and maintenance of irrigation systems in the State.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for
- 9 maintenance and improvements to the Peekauai ditch irrigation
- 10 system located on the island of Kauai.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 14 maintenance and improvements to the Peekauai ditch irrigation
- 15 system located on the island of Kauai, also known as Menehune
- 16 ditch, and all appurtenances.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
