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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

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RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2       general obligation bonds in the sum of \$10,400,000 or so much  
3       thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4       as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023  
5       for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
6       the twenty-first representative district, as follows:

7       To be expended by the department of education:

8       A. Ala Wai elementary school, Oahu

the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is

2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the  
4 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
