A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LOANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be
- 4 deposited into the agricultural loan revolving fund.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the agricultural
- 6 loan revolving fund the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the purpose of
- 8 funding class D emergency loans made pursuant to section 155-
- 9 (e), Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that the department of
- 10 agriculture may approve emergency loans of up to \$1,500,000 in
- 11 excess of the \$5,000,000 annual ceiling for the agricultural
- 12 loan revolving fund during a state of emergency declared by the
- 13 governor pursuant to chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

Agricultural Loans; Agricultural Loan Revolving Fund; Appropriation

Description:

Appropriates funds into and out of the agricultural loan revolving fund to fund class D emergency loans. Provides that the department of agriculture may approve emergency loans of up to \$1,500,000 in excess of the \$5,000,000 annual ceiling for the agricultural loan revolving fund during a state of emergency declared by the governor pursuant to chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
