A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION REVIEWS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 6E-8, Hawaii
- 2 Revised Statutes, plays an important role in the protection and
- 3 management of the State's historic properties and burial sites.
- 4 Section 6E-8(b) requires the department of Hawaiian home lands,
- 5 prior to any proposed project relating to lands under its
- 6 jurisdiction, to consult with the department of land and natural
- 7 resources regarding the effect of the project upon historic
- 8 property or a burial site. The purpose of this Act is to allow
- 9 the department of Hawaiian home lands to directly assume review
- 10 of proposed projects relating to lands under its jurisdiction,
- 11 rather than consulting the department of land and natural
- 12 resources for the effect of those projects upon historic
- 13 properties or burial sites.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 6E-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 16 "(b) [The] Notwithstanding subsection (a) to the contrary,
- 17 the department of Hawaiian home lands[, prior to] may assume

15		preservation digital document management system and			
16		library;			
17	(3)	Provided the department with:			
18		(A) Written notice that the department of Hawaiian			
19		home lands has employed a qualified preservation			
20		officer;			

1		<u>(B)</u>	A description of the procedures that the
2			department of Hawaiian home lands will employ to
3			ensure that all of the documentation identified
4			in paragraph (2) will be provided to the
5			department; and
6	(4)	Prov	ided the department with written notice of the
7		date	on which the department of Hawaiian home lands
8		will	assume responsibility for project review under
9		this	section and posted this information on the
10		depa	rtment of Hawaiian home lands' website; provided
11		furt	her that the written notice shall be provided at
12		leas	t forty-five days prior to the date on which the
13		depa	rtment of Hawaiian home lands assumes such
14		resp	onsibility.
15	The depar	tment	shall retain authority for review under this
16	section f	or pr	ojects affecting properties listed or nominated
17	for inclu	sion	in the Hawaii register of historic places or the
18	national	regis	ter of historic places or located in a designated
19	historic	distr	ict."

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Allows the department of Hawaiian home lands to assume historic preservation review of the effect of any proposed project for lands under its jurisdiction under certain conditions and except for projects affecting properties listed or nominated for inclusion in the Hawaii register of historic places or the national register of historic places or located in a designated historic district. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
