## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE HIGHWAY SAFETY COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to reduce the
- 2 appointed membership of the state highway safety council from
- 3 twenty to ten.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 286-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "\$286-5 State highway safety council. There is
- 7 established the Hawaii highway safety council placed within the
- 8 department of transportation. The director of transportation
- 9 shall serve as its chairperson. The following or their
- 10 designated representatives shall be members of the council: the
- 11 chief justice, the attorney general, the director of health, the
- 12 superintendent of education, the president of the University of
- 13 Hawaii, the chairperson of each of the county highway safety
- 14 councils established under section 286-6, and [not more than
- 15 twenty] ten other persons who shall be appointed by the governor
- 16 on the basis of their interest in highway safety.

1 The state highway safety council shall advise the governor on matters relating to the programs and activities of the State 2 3 in the field of highway safety. 4 The members of the council shall serve without pay but 5 shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses while 6 attending meetings and while in discharge of their duties." 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
