A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COASTAL EROSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The University of Hawaii shall establish
- 2 and implement a two-year program to study the impact of sandbag
- 3 walls, often referred to as "sand burritos", on sand movement
- 4 patterns and coastal erosion and on public trust resources,
- 5 including beach access, coastal water quality, and recreation,
- 6 at Ehukai beach park, including from the shoreline area near Ke
- 7 Iki road to Sunset beach.
- 8 (b) The University of Hawaii shall submit a report of its
- 9 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 10 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 11 to the convening of the regular session of 2025.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 15 study the impact of sandbag walls or "sand burritos" on sand
- 16 movement patterns and coastal erosion and on public trust
- 17 resources, including beach access, coastal water quality, and

- 1 recreation, at Ehukai beach park, including from the shoreline
- 2 area near Ke Iki road to Sunset beach.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act; provided that the moneys
- 5 appropriated by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the
- 6 2022-2023 fiscal year; provided further that any moneys that
- 7 remain unencumbered on June 30, 2024, shall lapse on that date.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
