

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$24,750,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-fourth representative district, as follows:

8 Plans, design, construction, and
9 equipment for expansion of the school
10 roadway and turnaround area for student
11 drop-off and pick-up; ground and site
12 improvements; and equipment and
13 appurtenances.

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
9 shall be expended by the state public charter school commission.

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
12 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
13 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
14 of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
