A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE GOVERNOR FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND INNOVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that due to the COVID-19
- 2 pandemic, the small business community has suffered tremendous
- 3 economic loss. Due to the lack of tourists arriving in the
- 4 state, as well as the subsequent economic downturn, there has
- 5 never been a greater need for small business assistance,
- 6 leadership, and vision.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the office of the
- 8 governor of Hawaii could benefit from the addition of an advisor
- 9 specifically attuned and directed towards economic development.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to assist in the job creation
- 11 process by creating a special assistant to the governor of the
- 12 state of Hawaii for entrepreneurship and innovation.
- 13 SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by adding
- 14 a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read as
- 15 follows:

16 "Chapter .

1	SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE GOVERNOR FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND
2	INNOVATION.
3	There is established within the office of the governor a
4	special assistant to the governor for entrepreneurship and
5	innovation. This position shall serve the need of the small
6	business community through advising the governor on promotion,
7	planning, and the providing of services to assist small
8	businesses in understanding and participating in job growth
9	through permit application processing and public procurements in
10	the State."
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
