8	2022, the department shall elect, pursuant to title 34 Code of
9	Federal Regulations section 303.211, to include in its
10	application, a state policy under which a parent or guardian of
11	a child with a disability:
12	(1) Who is eligible for preschool services under section
13	619 of the Individuals with Disabilities Education
14	Act, as amended; and

(2) Previously received early intervention services,

- 1 to choose that the early intervention services continue after
- 2 the child turns three years of age and until the child enters or
- 3 is eligible to enter kindergarten."
