A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE TAX EXAMINATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 231, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§231- Failure to respond during an inspection or
- 5 examination. (a) Any person who fails to respond or reply to
- 6 the department's correspondence or inquiry within a timely
- 7 manner during an inspection or examination of records under
- 8 section 231-3(6) shall be subject to a penalty equal to twenty-
- 9 five per cent of the tax owed; provided that the penalty shall
- 10 not exceed \$10,000.
- 11 (b) The director may waive the penalty imposed in
- 12 subsection (a) if the failure was due to reasonable cause."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
