## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FURLOUGH AND DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to 3
- fund residential drug treatment, therapeutic living, and mental 4
- 5 health programs that allow judiciary-involved women to bring
- 6 their minor children into the program to reduce the risks of
- 7 trauma and multigenerational incarceration.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
- 9 the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$
- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for 12
- 13 existing community-based furlough programs.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
