Sirs:

Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the House of Representatives to the amendments proposed by the Senate in H.B. No. 2510, H.D. 2, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO INCOME,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to incrementally:

- (1) Increase the State's minimum wage to \$12.00 per hour beginning October 1, 2022; \$15.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2024; and \$18.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2026; and
- (2) Phase out the tip credit.

Your Committee on Conference finds that while the cost of living in the State continues to rise, the minimum wage has not been adjusted to a level that is necessary to offset the higher cost of

living. Your Committee on Conference further finds that increasing the minimum wage will help to foster economic stability.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by:

- (1)Inserting a preamble;
- (2) Inserting provisions that make the State earned income tax credit refundable and permanent, and providing for the carryforward of nonrefundable tax credits previously claimed;
- Changing the timespan and staggering of the minimum wage increases from \$12.00 on October 1, 2022; \$15.00 on January 1, 2024; and \$18.00 on January 1, 2026; to \$12.00 on October 1, 2022; \$14.00 on January 1, 2024; \$16.00 on January 1, 2026; and \$18.00 on January 1, 2028; and
- Instead of phasing out the tip credit, increasing the tip credit incrementally to \$1.50 per hour over a six-year period.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the managers of your Committee on Conference that is attached to this report, your Committee on Conference is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2510, H.D. 2, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Final Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2510, H.D. 2, S.D. 1, C.D. 1.
