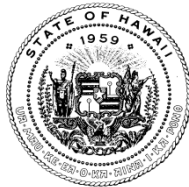

H.B. 1109, H.D. 2
RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING

Senate Committees on Judiciary

The Department of Transportation (DOT) supports H.B. 1109, H.D. 2, which will meet federal requirements on fraudulent activity relating to Commercial Learner's Permit (CLP) and Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

The DOT is required by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, pursuant to title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations section 383.73(k)(2), to have policies in effect that result, at minimum, in the disqualification of the CLP or CDL for applicants who are suspected of fraud related to the testing and issuance of that CLP or CDL.
