## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INCREASE THE  
PARKING CAPACITY OF THE ONEULA BEACH PARK PARKING LOT AND  
TO CONSTRUCT A KITCHEN RINSE-OUT FACILITY AT THE BEACH  
PARK.

1           WHEREAS, Oneula Beach Park is a popular beach park located  
2 in Ewa Beach, Hawaii, that provides recreational opportunities  
3 for residents and visitors alike; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, the neighborhood surrounding Oneula Beach Park has  
6 experienced significant growth in recent years, resulting in  
7 increased use of the park and its facilities; and  
8

9           WHEREAS, the existing parking lot at Oneula Beach Park is  
10 not sufficient to accommodate the increased use of the park,  
11 leading to overcrowding and safety concerns; and  
12

13           WHEREAS, there is currently no environmentally safe  
14 facility at Oneula Beach Park for users to rinse out food  
15 equipment after use, which can lead to contamination of the park  
16 grounds and its waters; now, therefore,

18           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
19 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
20 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the City and County  
21 of Honolulu is requested to increase the parking capacity of the  
22 Oneula Beach Park parking lot to address the increased use of  
23 the park due to the growth of the surrounding neighborhood; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu  
26 is requested to construct a kitchen facility at Oneula Beach  
27 Park to provide an environmentally safe facility for park users  
28 to rinse out food equipment; and
