A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
STATE OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2 amendment to article II of the Constitution of the State of
3 Hawaii to allow the State to enact laws establishing limitations
4 on moneys expended by any independent expenditure committee to
5 influence the outcome of a state election.

6 SECTION 2. Article II of the Constitution of the State of
7 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
8 designated and to read as follows:

9 "INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE COMMITTEES, EXPENDITURE LIMITS

10 Section . Limitations on moneys expended by any
11 independent expenditure committee to influence the outcome of a
12 state election shall be provided by law."

13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
14 be as follows:

15 "Shall the Hawaii State Constitution be amended to allow
16 the Legislature to enact laws establishing limitations on




1 moneys expended by any independent expenditure committee to
2 influence the outcome of a state election?"

3 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

4 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
5 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
6 the State of Hawaii.
