
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXCESSIVE NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 63, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended
2 by amending section 2 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the state highway
4 fund the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and [~~the same sum or so much~~
6 ~~thereof as may be necessary~~] \$ _____ for fiscal year 2024-
7 2025 for the purposes of this Act.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of transportation for the purposes of this Act."

10 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
11 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
12 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
13 appropriations contained in H.B. No. _____, will cause the state
14 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
15 exceeded by \$ _____ or _____ per cent. In addition, the
16 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
17 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further



1 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
2 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
3 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
4 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
5 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
6 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

7 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
8 serve the public interest; and

9 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
10 addressed by this Act.

11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
