# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING PRIVATE BUSINESSES WITH THIRTY OR MORE EMPLOYEES TO  
HAVE AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR ON-SITE.

1           WHEREAS, more than 356,000 out-of-hospital cardiac arrests  
2 are reported annually in the United States, of which seventy to  
3 ninety percent of people experiencing out-of-hospital cardiac  
4 arrests die before reaching a hospital; and

5

6           WHEREAS, research has shown that for each minute that  
7 passes without defibrillation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation,  
8 the chance of survival from sudden cardiac arrest decreases by  
9 seven to ten percent; and

10

11           WHEREAS, automated external defibrillators are an important  
12 tool in responding to emergency situations; and

13

14           WHEREAS, nine in ten cardiac arrest victims who receive a  
15 shock from an automated external defibrillator in the first  
16 minute live; and

17

18           WHEREAS, the placement of automated external defibrillators  
19 at public locations where cardiac arrest is most likely to  
20 occur, such as schools, government buildings, airports, fitness  
21 centers, churches, and workplaces, has been found to increase  
22 out-of-hospital cardiac arrest survival, increase rates of  
23 return of spontaneous circulation, and improve neurological  
24 outcomes for patients; and

26           WHEREAS, ensuring that these lifesaving tools are available  
27 in certain private businesses in the State will maximize  
28 survival should a life-threatening emergency occur; now,

# H.C.R. NO. 86

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
2 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
3 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that private businesses  
4 with thirty or more employees are encouraged to have an  
5 automated external defibrillator on-site; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the private businesses are  
8 requested to ensure that their employees are properly trained in  
9 the use of an automated external defibrillator; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President and Chief  
13 Executive Officer of the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii.
