HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT TO EVALUATE SUBSIDIZING PUBLIC TRANSIT FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, it is a policy and goal of the State to 1 decarbonize our economy by 2045 and to achieve zero fossil fuel 2 3 emissions in the transportation sector; and 4 WHEREAS, vehicle miles traveled, or VMT, is a proxy for 5 6 measuring ground transportation emissions and the robustness of transportation options; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the reduction of VMT improves health, environmental, and economic outcomes for all residents, and is 10 an integral part of reaching the State's zero emissions goal; 11 12 and 13 WHEREAS, reducing VMT requires support for alternative 14 forms of transportation and a reduction of private vehicle 15 16 usage; and 17 WHEREAS, emissions per passenger mile on public transit, 18 19 such as buses or rail, are far lower than private vehicles, and even lower when ridership is higher; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, support for public transit also has other net positive benefits including better land use and improved air 23 24 quality; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the State should lead by example and incentivize multimodal public transportation for its employees; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, there is an existing pilot program for full-time employees of the executive branch to deduct the cost of bus 30 passes pre-tax, which could be expanded to offer more generous 31

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incentives and include temporary and part-time state employees; 1 2 and 3 4 WHEREAS, subsidies are already provided to some state 5 employees who drive private vehicles, in the form of workplace parking in state facilities at rates that are far below market 6 rates for dedicated parking; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, providing free or subsidized public transportation 10 access would greatly incentivize state employees to utilize options like bus or rail transit systems; now, therefore, 11 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 14 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, that the Department of Accounting and General 15 16 Services and Department of Human Resources Development are urged to collaboratively evaluate options to encourage the use and 17 subsidize the cost of public transportation for state employees; 18 19 and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, 22 23 Comptroller, Director of Human Resources Development, Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, Director 24 of Transportation, Chief Energy Officer, Director of the Office 25 26 of Planning and Sustainable Development, and Co-Chairs of the 27 Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption Commission. 28 29 OFFERED BY: MAR 0 8 2024 30



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
