A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PORT INFRASTRUCTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that maintenance dredging
- 2 is critical to the maintenance of small boat harbors, channels,
- 3 ramps, and other port infrastructure in the State. The
- 4 legislature further finds that the current system of waiting
- 5 until dredging is imminent to appropriate funds and only then
- 6 initiating the permitting process creates a haphazard system for
- 7 both the allocation of money and the issuance of permits. This
- 8 disorganized process sometimes contributes to worsened
- 9 conditions at these facilities when increased amounts of marine
- 10 sediment and foreign debris accumulate, sometimes up to such a
- 11 height that, if not cleared immediately, it can damage the hulls
- 12 of ships. These conditions can potentially cause a shutdown of
- 13 the affected sites, which are important for recreation and
- 14 subsistence fishing and use by the general public, for safety
- 15 reasons.
- 16 The legislature further finds that federal agencies have
- 17 encouraged the states to adopt programmatic schedules of



- 1 maintenance dredging to expedite federal review and even draw
- 2 down federal dollars that are available to assist the states in
- 3 these endeavors. Creating a strategic plan for maintenance
- 4 dredging of small boat harbors, channels, ramps, and other port
- 5 infrastructure in the State will spread resources based on
- 6 actual need and allow ample time for permitting and public input
- 7 before port infrastructure reaches a critical stage.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 9 land and natural resources to create a strategic plan for
- 10 maintenance dredging of small boat harbors, channels, ramps, and
- 11 other important port infrastructure in the State.
- 12 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 13 shall create a strategic plan for maintenance dredging of small
- 14 boat harbors, channels, ramps, and other port infrastructure.
- 15 The strategic plan shall include:
- 16 (1) A list of potential projects in locations where the
- department has identified a need for maintenance
- 18 dredging;
- 19 (2) Detailed estimated costs of each project; and

- (3) A detailed timeline of each project until completion
 that prevents or minimizes closures or interruption of
 services at each project site.
- 4 The department shall submit a report, including the strategic
- 5 plan and any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
- 6 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 7 of 2025.
- 8 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 9 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 11 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
- 12 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- 13 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 14 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes
- 15 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 16 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act
- 17 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
- 18 ceiling are that:
- 19 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- 20 serve the public interest; and

1	(2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
2	addressed by this Act.
3	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
6	the purpose of creating a strategic plan for maintenance
7	dredging of harbor and port locations, as identified by the
8	department of land and natural resources.
9	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
1	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
